Student and Family Support

Virtual Summer Journey ELY was designed with multiple weekly touchpoints to ensure families are supported during these times.

Counseling Session

Students have a weekly session with a counselor who facilitates a virtual workshop on a pre-approved topic such as Growth Mindset or Managing Anxiety

Parent Workshop

Parents will be invited to join optional live virtual webinars with a licensed Catapult Learning counselor where they can learn and ask questions about supporting their child's academic and emotional needs during this time
