We are excited to announce the return of our **Summer Journey** summer school for June 2024. Summer school is free of charge with extraordinary course opportunities with hands-on instruction centered on reading, language arts, math, social studies, and science.

Included with this letter is key information to help ensure you complete our new **online Summer Journey Registration** for your child(ren):

- 1. Summer Journey enrollment form will be a part of the Northwest R-I annual online registration for the 2024-2025 school year. Annual online registration is available through Infinite Campus Parent Portal on the district website.
- 2. The form must be completed by the cutoff date of May 3, 2024. Registration will close the afternoon of May 3 at 4:00 p.m.

If you are the parent of a child who will be entering Kindergarten in the fall of 2024, I strongly encourage you to consider enrolling your child in **Summer Journey**. Attending summer school prior to Kindergarten helps our youngest learners acclimate to the school setting. We have noticed that not only are these students more prepared, but they are also eager to return in the fall and find that "first day of school" experience to be a positive one.

To make the summer school program even more enticing to students, an extensive incentive program is offered by **Summer Journey for grades K-8**. Students will be eligible to receive daily prizes if they: 1) come to school, 2) exhibit a positive attitude, and 3) work to improve their academic achievement. At the end of the program, some lucky students will also win grand prizes that will be awarded on the final day. Additionally, as in past years, all our students who demonstrate outstanding attendance will be rewarded with attendance recognition by our Summer School partner Catapult Learning.

We encourage all students to sign up for summer school. Simply put, it's good for kids. Please take a look at the information enclosed.

"Work" is fun in the four-weekly mini units Dinosaur Bones, Pat-A-Cake, At the Pet Shop, and Detectives for Hire. Students build on prior knowledge as they learn about a variety of careers. Each activity is designed to foster early learning concepts, such as letter and sound recognition, phonemic awareness, measurement, counting, and shape recognition. Thematic centers and literature-based math activities complete the morning. From digging for fossils to tracking down missing letters, this unit offers multi-level activities appropriate for all early learners.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What is the Summer Journey program?

The Northwest R-I School District Summer Journey is an extended learning summer program operated by Northwest R-I School District and Catapult Learning to provide a world-class educational experience to district students.

What does the program cost to parents?

The programming is free to all students.

When will the program be held?

The Northwest R-I Summer Journey program will be held from May 30 to June 28, 2024*. Times are from 8:35am-3:33pm for the elementary program, and 7:25am-2:23pm for the other programs. Some elementary buildings will not be hosting Summer Journey due to construction. Please look for communication in the near future about which schools will be hosting Summer Journey. This will not impact your child being able to attend, if their school building is impacted, they will be assigned a building and transportation will be provided to their assigned building.

*Dates may change based on the number of days missed due to inclement weather. Changes will be announced.

Will transportation be provided to and from the program?

Yes, transportation will be provided for those student families who qualify for transportation during the regular school year. However, bus routes will be limited and may vary from routes during the regular school year. Transportation information will be sent to those families who require transportation as soon as the plan becomes available. Students must enroll by 4PM on May 3 to be eligible for transportation.

What will my child(ren) do each day?

Throughout the day, Summer Journey students attend engaging academic classes where they may read interesting adventure stories, play language arts games, and/or use technology to solve math mysteries. A typical schedule would include four morning classes of Reading, Language Arts, Mathematics, and Science or Social Studies.

Students will also explore a variety of fun-filled courses that rotate for those enrolled in the program.

How does the incentive program work?

Many students will win daily incentives for their efforts through a daily drawing, or some similar format established by the summer site. Your student is also eligible to receive one of the following incentives for their Summer Journey attendance:

- Perfect Attendance = \$60 gift card
- Up To One Day Missed = \$45 gift card
- Over One Day, Up To Two Days Missed = \$30 gift card

Will breakfast and lunch be served every day?

Yes, students will be served breakfast and lunch using the same systems used during the regular school term. As a result, students should plan to purchase meals (or bring lunch) in the same way they do during the regular school year.
