


Puxico R-8 School Parents,

This summer, our District will offer K-8 students, free of charge, an enjoyable, exciting, and academic approach to learning called Summer Journey. This opportunity will not only be FUN for kids but will also provide an opportunity for students to experience over 140 hours of academics during the summer months. This academic time will give students the chance to review and apply previously learned skills and knowledge as well as prepare for the school year ahead. Our Summer Journey's educational goals are comprised of academic courses with hands-on instruction centered in Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math (STEM) in tandem with English Language Arts.

The courses will be relaxed – no homework or testing for grades – and will offer courses for hands-on discovery. Our Summer Journey courses will provide opportunities for students to interact with learning. Units such as Molecules and Mixtures and Rockets Plus supplement the regular academic year. There will be courses available for all age groups with an emphasis on fun.

If you are the parent of a child who will be entering Kindergarten (must turn 5 by August 1) in the fall of 2024, I strongly encourage you to consider enrolling your child in Summer Journey. This is a great opportunity for students to get accustomed to the school environment while getting a jumpstart on learning. When Pre-K students can meet teachers and fellow classmates it often lessens the stress on the 1st day of school helping to make a positive experience.

Finally, Summer Journey offers an incentive program for students. Students who attend every day, all day, will receive \$100 reward. Attendance Recognition gift cards range from \$50 for good attendance to \$100 for perfect attendance. Consistently attending school with a positive attitude helps students be successful during their academic years and beyond.

To say it simply, Summer Journey is good for kids. Enclosed you will find our Summer Journey program information. Please take the opportunity to review; I know you and your student will enjoy the experience.

Kids at Work

"Work" is fun in the four-weekly mini units Dinosaur Bones, Pat-A-Cake, At the Pet Shop, and Detectives for Hire. Students build on prior knowledge as they learn about a variety of careers. Each activity is designed to foster early learning concepts, such as letter and sound recognition, phonemic awareness, measurement, counting, and shape recognition. Thematic centers and literature-based math activities complete the morning. From digging for fossils to tracking down missing letters, this unit offers multi-level activities appropriate for all early learners.

BrickLAB STEAMventures

BrickLAB STEAMventures offers immersive hands-on activities that ignite young minds. Through exciting adventures exploring flight, transportation and food, learners build essential skills like counting, coloring and working as part of a team. This program fosters curiosity and creativity while introducing the core principles of science, technology, engineering, art and mathematics. FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What is the Summer Journey program?

The Puxico R-8 School District Summer Journey is an extended learning summer program operated by Puxico R-8 School District and Catapult Learning to provide a world-class educational experience to district students.

What does the program cost to parents?

The programming is free to all students.

When will the program be held?

The Puxico R-8 School District Summer Journey operates daily from 8:00 AM to 3:10 PM. The program will run five days per week, May 28, 2024 through June 21, 2024*.

*Dates may change based on the number of days missed due to inclement weather. Changes will be announced.

Must my child be in attendance every hour of the program to receive credit for the Summer Journey program?

No. We understand students may have vacations or camps planned. While prizes for good attendance are available to students, a child's occasional absence should not deter parents from enrolling their children in the program.

Will transportation be provided to and from the program?

Yes, transportation will be provided for those student families who qualify for transportation during the regular school year. However, bus routes will be limited and may vary from routes during the regular school year. Transportation information will be sent to those families who require transportation as soon as the plan becomes available.

What will my child(ren) do each day?

In the morning, Summer Journey students attend engaging academic classes where they may read interesting adventure stories, play language arts games, and/or use technology to solve math mysteries. A typical schedule would include four morning classes of Reading, Language Arts, Mathematics, and Science or Social Studies.

After lunch, students will explore a variety of funfilled courses that rotate for those enrolled in the program.

How does the incentive program work?

Many students will win daily incentives for their efforts through a daily drawing, or some similar format established by the summer site. Your student is also eligible to receive one of the following incentives for their Summer Journey attendance:

- 0 Minutes Missed = \$100 gift card
- .001 Minutes to 6.667 Hours Missed = \$75 gift card
- 6.668 to 13.334 Hours Missed = \$50 gift card

Will breakfast and lunch be served every day?

Yes, the District has applied for a special state grant whereby ALL students would receive a free breakfast and lunch daily. In the event the grant is not approved, breakfast and lunch will be served using the same systems that are currently in place.

How do I enroll my child for Summer Journey?

Simply fill out the enrollment form found in the front pocket of this brochure and return it to your child's school.
