About ECRI

Enhanced Core Reading Instruction (ECRI) is an evidence-based literacy system developed by the University of Oregon's Center on Teaching and Learning to increase the efficiency and effectiveness of reading instruction in kindergarten, first, and second grade. This multi-tiered instruction and intervention system embedded within a targeted professional learning model has been proven to close the gap for striving readers.

Featuring a series of explicit and systematic teaching routines designed to increase the efficiency and effectiveness of reading instruction, ECRI enhances core reading programs to achieve more favorable outcomes for all students, and especially those who may be struggling.

The Teacher Workbook

The Teacher Workbook, required for each teacher, interventionist, and leader, features explicit teaching routines in the foundational skill areas of phonemic awareness, phonics and word recognition, decodable text reading, fluency, vocabulary, comprehension, and dictation. These routines are designed to be taught in a specific way, using consistent language and following the same procedures each time the routine is used.

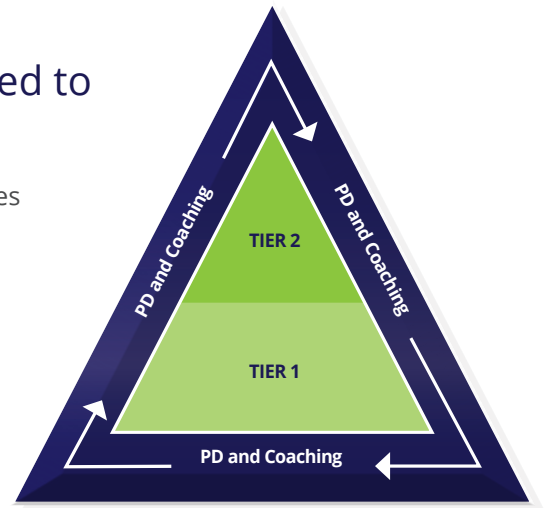

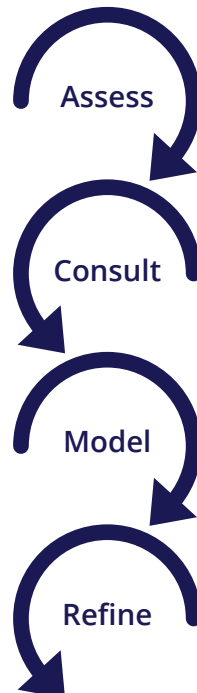


Job-Embedded ECRI Coaching

Foundational Skills Sessions (2 Full Days)

This workshop explores evidence-based reading instruction and models the use of instructional routines to enhance Tier 1 and Tier 2 support in a multi-tiered system. Participants will learn strategies to improve the efficiency and effectiveness of reading instruction for K–2 students, including aligning interventions with core instruction, using assessment data to guide teaching, and implementing routines focused on key reading components.

Participants will be able to understand:

- How aligning Tier 1 and Tier 2 reading instruction can lead to high student reading outcomes.
- The elements of enhancing core reading instruction.
- The essential components of beginning reading instruction.
- The instructional components of a Foundational Skills Lesson and be able to describe the order of skills.
- How using instructional routines can enhance current core reading instruction.

ECRI Vocabulary and Comprehension Sessions (1 Full Day)

This workshop focuses on evidence-based reading instruction, demonstrating how instructional routines can enhance vocabulary and comprehension teaching for K-2 students. Participants will explore systematic strategies to improve the efficiency of core reading instruction, incorporating explicit elements, active engagement, and multiple practice opportunities.

Participants will be able to:

- Identify the essential components of instructional routines related to active student engagement strategies, specific-word vocabulary instruction, personal recounts, narrative text instruction, and information text instruction.
- Plan a specific-word vocabulary lesson, a narrative text lesson, and an information text lesson.

ECRI Leadership for Foundational Skills (1 Full Day)

This session includes a classroom walkthrough and workshop designed to equip leaders with resources and strategies to support effective implementation of Enhanced Core Reading Instruction (ECRI). Recommended for leaders who have completed the Foundational Skills 2-Day session, this course covers evidence-based reading practices, instructional routines for core reading instruction within a multi-tiered system, and tools for implementation monitoring.

Participants will learn to:

- Present research on evidence-based practices.
- Explain key elements of instructional routines and their importance.
- Model routines for Tier 1 and Tier 2 instruction.
- Use data to guide coaching and professional development.

ECRI Leadership for Vocabulary and Comprehension (1 Full Day)

This session, featuring a classroom walkthrough and workshop, is designed for school leaders supporting ECRI implementation. Leaders will explore evidence-based reading practices, learn to model instructional routines, and gain tools to enhance vocabulary and comprehension instruction within a multi-tiered system.

Participants will be able to:

- Outline how ECRI vocabulary and comprehension routines are integrated into the reading block structure.
- Describe how to use vocabulary and comprehension instructional routines to enhance the delivery of core reading instruction for ALL students.
- Collect and use implementation data to support school teams with delivery of vocabulary and comprehension instruction.
- Guide school teams to effectively roll-out ECRI vocabulary and comprehension following a schedule.
